Downing and Kyle R. and Heather L. Downing, W377 S5994 CTH ZC, Dousman, WI, to legalize and retain an existing In-Law Unit and conduct minor modifications thereto. The second Public Hearing request is to terminate the non-operative commercial dog kennel on the same property.
