ORDINANCE NO. 2-266

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE HARDCRABBLE ROAD AND PIPER ROAD AS CLASS "B"  
HIGHWAYS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 349.15 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes Section 349.159(2) OF THE Wisconsin Statutes provides that, except with regard to a highway which is a state trunk highway or a connecting highway, the Town Board may designate all or any part of a highway maintained by it as a "Class B" highway and to hereby impose the weight limitations set forth in Section 348.16 of the Wisconsin Statutes on such highway; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of OTTAWA has responsibility for maintaining the highways in the Town of OTTAWA; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board finds that the designation of Hardscrabble Road and Piper Road in the Town of OTTAWA as a Class "B" highway is necessary to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of the Town of OTTAWA;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of OTTAWA, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 349.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes, Hardscrabble Road and Piper Road in the Town of OTTAWA are designated as a Class B highway and shall be subject to the weight limitations imposed by Section 348.16 of the Wisconsin Statutes and provisions referenced therein, and as amended from time to time, which are adopted herein and incorporated by reference.

SECTION 2: Except as permitted under Section 348.16(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, any person violating the Class B weight limits under Section 348.16 of the Wisconsin Statutes shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to the policy in prosecuting weight violations and penalty provisions as set forth in Sections 348.20, and 348.21 of the Wisconsin Statutes and provisions referenced therein, and as amended from time-to-time, which are adopted herein and incorporated by reference.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof in the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
